Reminders from Tamarack Maintenance/Landscape

Fall leaf cleanup on roofs and gutters is scheduled for late Oct. early Nov.

If you have a heat wire it should be plugged in for when temps are consistently below 40 degrees.

If you are bringing yard waste to the landscape dumpster, please no trash bags should be put in the dumpster. Empty yard waste from bags.

Outdoor water bibs / water spigots need to be turned off when temps are 40 degrees and lower.
