- a. Update on Walkaround data: compilation continues, plan for more in depth discussion at November meeting. Suggestion made to have information from year prior as part of walkaround sheets for easy reference. Added suggestion made that priority be given to safety concerns which includes a rating scale. Concern raised is that there are some Tamarack units that cannot be fully visually inspected due to elevation or other lack of access. It was noted that Tamarack Trails is an aging facility with deteriorating trim and wood rot concerns which requires ongoing attention. Suggestion made to explore having Maintenance Committee member team with ARB for Walkaround as has been done in past.
- **b.** Welcome Committee reception for new owners held on September 19th. New residents in attendance age demographic is younger than previous recent events. It was noted that Tamarack Trails units are more affordable for first time homebuyers than most properties on the market.
