Board and Committee Business

Board Meeting Notes – June 24, 2025

This is an informal report about the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Directors. Official minutes will be posted on the Tamarack website after approval by the Board.

Pool Update:

- The board approved signing of the final loan documents by the President and Treasurer with Alliance Bank for \$600,000 to pay the remaining cost of the pool renovation.
- A new pool access system is being investigated. Key cards are not needed at this time.
- The board approved extending the pool season by one week to a closing date of Sunday, September 28, 2025, based on weather and lifeguard availability.

Motions approved by the board:

- **Viktor's Painting LLC** in the amount of \$88,300 for exterior painting. Homes to be done:
 - o Pine Ridge: 101-123, 127-144
 - o Randolph: 201-215
 - o Tree Lane: 7379-7423, 7441, 7445
- **JR's Mulch Sales** in the amount of \$35,454.60. We are on a 2-year mulch rotation. This year, mulch will be spread at homes on the east side of Westfield and south of Tree Lane. Additional mulch will be available for resident use at Tamarack.
- **Neighbors for a Greener Tamarack** has been authorized to submit a Plant Dane, grant application for free native plants. Their preferred planting location is at four trail signs on Tree Lane.
- Following the financial audit, excess Operating Funds in the amount of \$100,000 will be transferred to the Reserve Fund to help fund unbudgeted reserve expenditures.
- New members to the **Ad-Hoc Website Work Group** are Alexandra Fedorova, Ellen Foley, Jayne Meyer, Gabrial Rotberg and Henrik Rydberg.

April 2025 Financial Statements were reviewed.

 - b) Reserve \$871,859.27
- 2. May 30, 2025, Investment Account Balances which are part of the Reserve Fund.

ARB News & Updates

Minimum Information for Submitting Requests to the ARB

The ARB expects to receive ARB requests for their next meeting 14 days in advance. Much of this intervening time ARB may be spent making a site visit, checking for BOS compliance, reviewing the documentation supplied by the unit owner attached to a submittal form, Form 1 or 2., and "playing phone/email tag" with the unit owner to secure items needed for a complete request. Owners should share BOS with contractors and review the possible need for a permit from the City of Madison. See also BOS, III.A. – G. found on the Tamarack Webpage.

Minimally, a request should include:

- A completed form, including unit owner contact information
- A brief description of project (new or replacement) and photos of exterior location(s)
- The product description, vendor and contractor contact information
- The estimated date of construction, contractor certificate of insurance, and
- Any comments from neighbors within view.

Attachments to the Unit Exterior

As per the Book of Standards, IV., attachments to a unit's exterior trim, is not allowed unless so stated in BOS and ARB approval is obtained.

Some decorative items or small battery-operated/solar security lights or cameras may easily be attached to siding without adding nails or screws. There are various <u>vinyl siding clips</u> available locally and online. Just check to make sure the weight of the item to be attached is suitable for the fastener chosen.

Why is ARB concerned about exterior attachments? Remember the exterior is the responsibility of the Association; therefore, any attachment may impact the life of the exterior element and/or require additional time and resources when staff or vendors are maintaining the building exterior. As with holiday décor and other items placed on the lawn or in garden areas, they must not impede maintenance operations and may need to be removed temporarily while various work is conducted. When considering making such attachments, unit owners must be mindful of maintaining the integrity of the external design and character of Tamarack as stated in the BOS.
